15	violation of the Magnuson Moss Warranty Act, 15 U.S.C. §2301, and for declaratory relief.		
16	Defendant L.L. Bean Inc. has moved to dismiss the complaint and to strike the class action		
17	allegations. (Dkt. Nos. 16, 18.)		
18	Having carefully considered the briefing and arguments submitted in this matter, and for		
19	the reasons set forth in full detail on the record on August 14, 2018, the motions to Dismiss and to		
20	Strike are GRANTED WITH LEAVE TO AMEND. The request for judicial notice submitted by		
21	defendant in support of the motion to dismiss is GRANTED IN PART as to Exhibits C, D, and E		
22	only.		
23	Plaintiff shall file his amended complaint no later than September 13, 2018. Defendant		
24	shall file its response 21 days thereafter.
